

Collapsed in Heat Wave

Margaret Masterson, aged 8 years, of Chapman Street, Braddon, collapsed on Friday evening while playing with other children, including her younger brother, John. Her death on Saturday was attributed to the effect of the heat.

The funeral yesterday was attended by a representative gathering, including officers of the Department of the Interior, where the child's father is employed.

Rev. Father Barry officiated at the funeral at the Roman Catholic portion of the Public Cemetery.

John Roberts, gardener, aged 85, late of Cunningham Street, Kingston, collapsed and died while working at Mugga Way on Saturday afternoon. Death was due to the extreme heat. The body was transferred to the Canberra Morgue.
